### LOUISIANA (Pelican State)



The 31st state in the USA, Louisiana was named after King Louis XIV of France in 1682. The Mississippi River runs through the state to the Gulf of Mexico, creating the most Wetlands of all the states. At its lowest point it is 2m (8ft) below sea level and is often flooded, caused by tropical storms and hurricanes. The 'Lake Pontchartrain Causeway' is the longest bridge over water (continuous) in the world at 38.35km (23.83 miles).

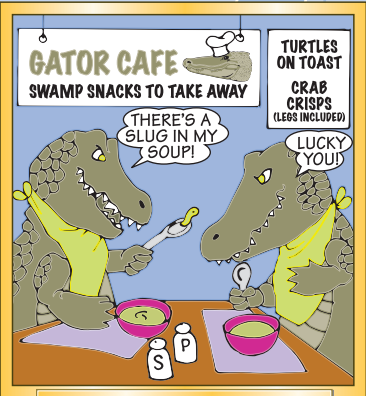

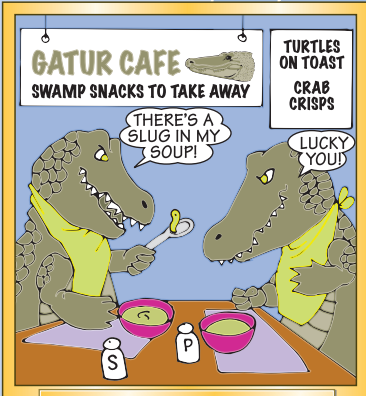
