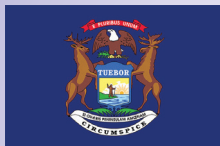

MICHIGAN (Great Lakes State)



Michigan became the 26th state of the USA in 1837. It is the only state that has borders with four of the five 'Great Lakes' Huron, Erie, Michigan and Superior.

Divided into two Peninsulars, it has more shoreline than any other state except Alaska and has over 11,000 lakes, making it one of the largest states (11th) in the USA.

State Capital - Lansing
Largest City - Detroit
The name Michigan is derived from the Indian word 'mishigamaa' meaning 'large water' or large lake'.
