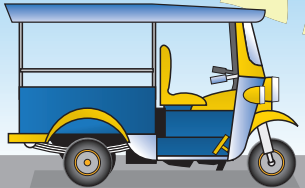

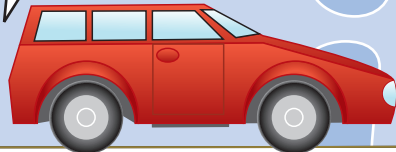
TUK TUK

The Tuk-Tuk is a small 3-wheeled vehicle which originated in Japan in the 1950s. Since then, it has mainly been produced in Thailand where it replaced the Rickshaw for transporting people and goods. It has handlebar control instead of a steering wheel.

It has become a very popular type of taxi and its name is derived from the sound its engine makes while idling.

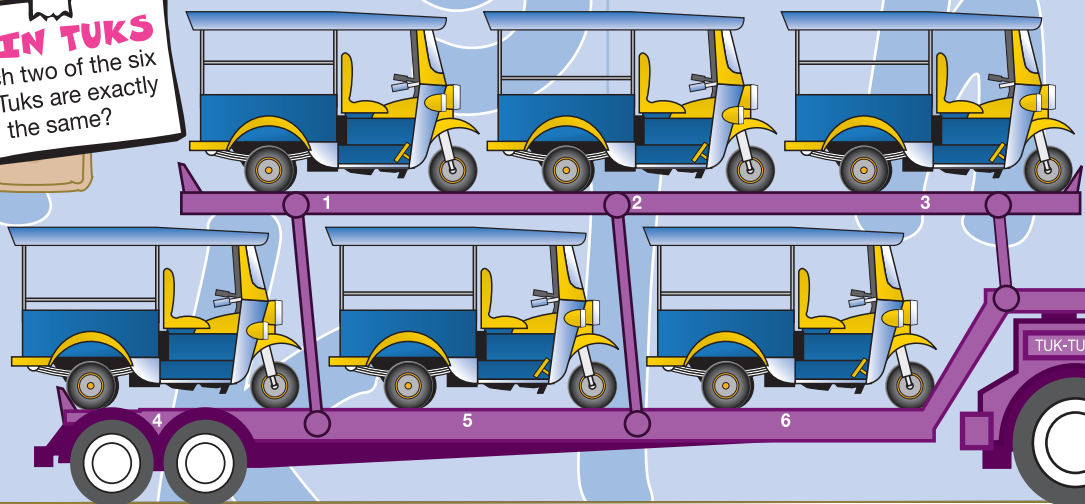
